Taking care of your sewer network in Windhill / Muir of Ord.

What we are doing

As you will be aware, we are currently carrying out work to upgrade sewers in Windhill / Muir of Ord to help reduce the risk of sewer flooding by reducing the risk of pipes bursting. Part of this work involved crossing the A862. We had hoped to be able to drill the pipe under the road, however the ground conditions are such that we are unable to do so. As such, we now need to install the pipe across the A862 by open cut trench method (See overleaf for details of works location in the A862).

When are we doing it

Work is planned to start in the A862 from Tuesday 6th May 2025 for approximately 6 weeks.

What happens next

- This section of works will involve a lane closure in the A862 with temporary traffic lights. As work progresses the lane closure will flip to the other lane. Traffic lights will be in place to manage the flow of traffic safely through the lane closure area.
- During these works, vehicle access will be maintained to both the access road to Windhill and the access road to Tomich House.
- All working areas will be securely fenced off to ensure the safety of the public and our site team. Pedestrian Access will be maintained at all times.
- Our contractor Pat Munro Construction Ltd. will be carrying out this work on our behalf and they will do all they can to keep disruption to a minimum as much as possible.
