Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 Scottish Water Strategic Plan - A Sustainable Future Together Screening Report

Thank you for your Screening Report consultation which SEPA received via the Scottish Government SEA Gateway on 17 December 2019.

In accordance with Section 9(3) of the Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 we have considered your screening report using the criteria set out in Schedule 2 for determining the likely significance of effects on the environment. Our consideration of the screening report has also been informed by the very useful discussion we had with yourselves prior to your submission of the report.

We understand that the strategic plan is a very high level document and as such it is difficult to ascertain the nature of any potential significant effects which may result in respect of our main areas of interest (air, water, soil, human health, material assets and climatic factors).
