The consultation proposes to change reservoir subsistence fees as follows:

High risk: increase by 27% Medium risk: increase by 26% Low risk: increase by 26%

The reason for such substantial increases is not clear from the consultation document. Greater transparency is required on what has driven the increases.

The consultation explains that the time taken to regulate the different risk categories has been considered. This suggests that each category requires different work inputs from SEPA. However, it is not clear how this is reflected in the revised fees as a similar percentage increase has been applied to all risk categories.

It is also not clear to what extent efficiency measures have been included within the review of the charges.
