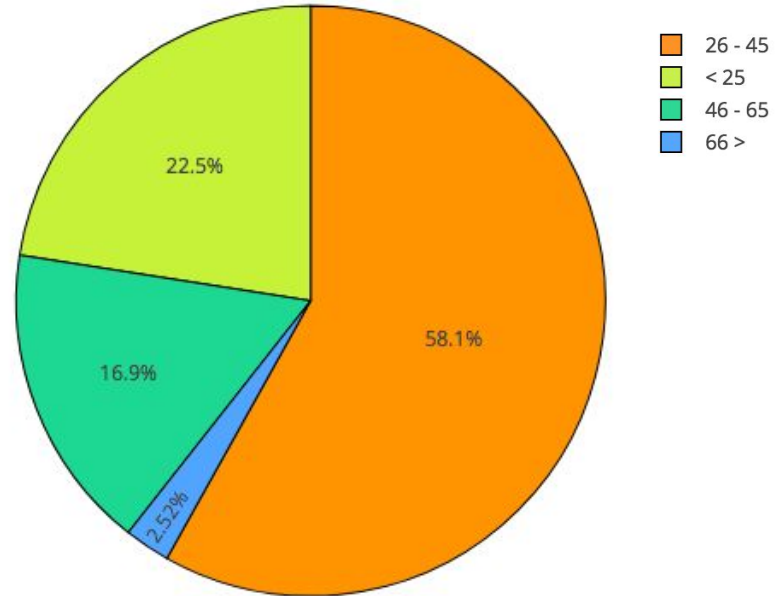

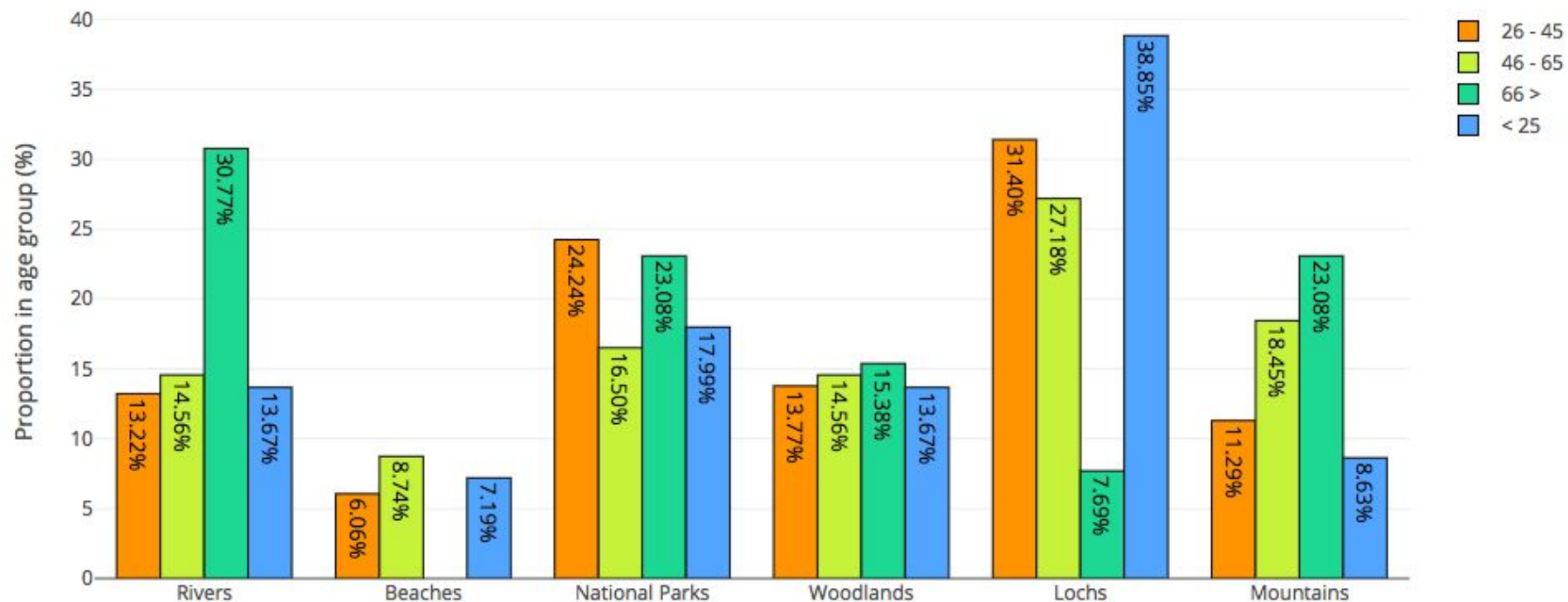

## Age groups



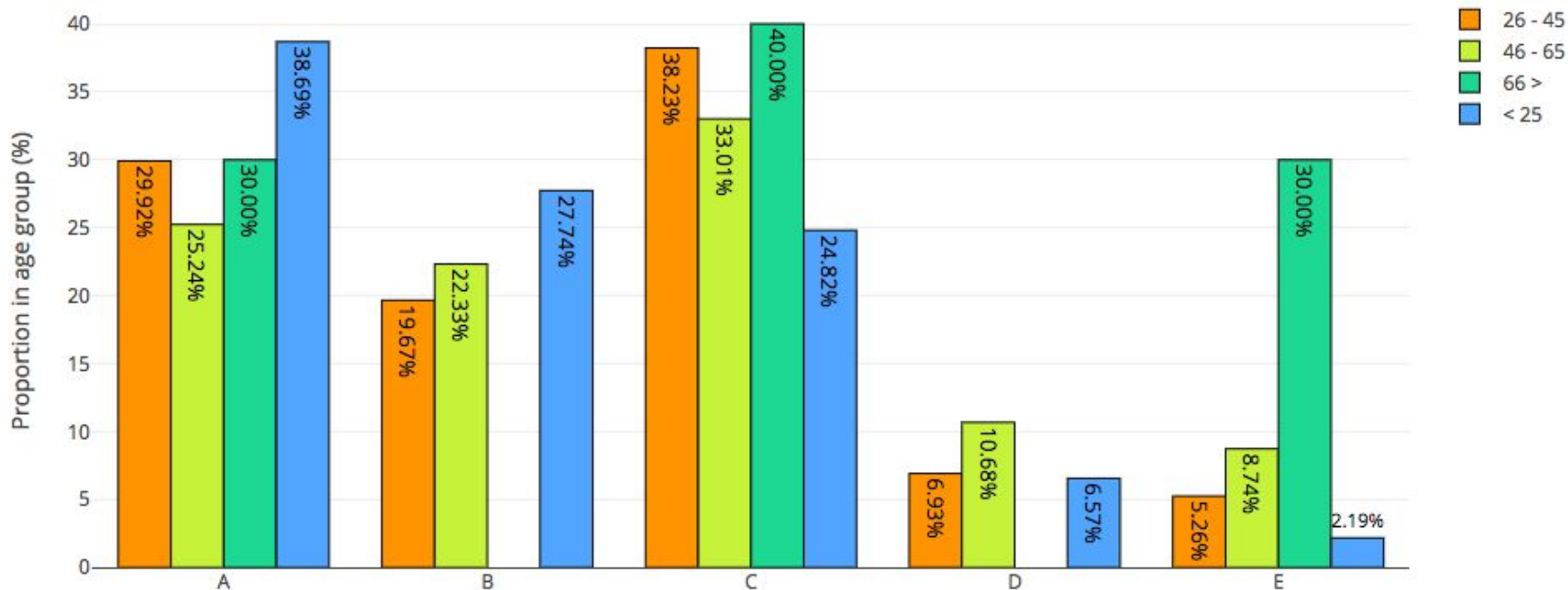

## What do you think is the biggest threat to Scotland's environment?

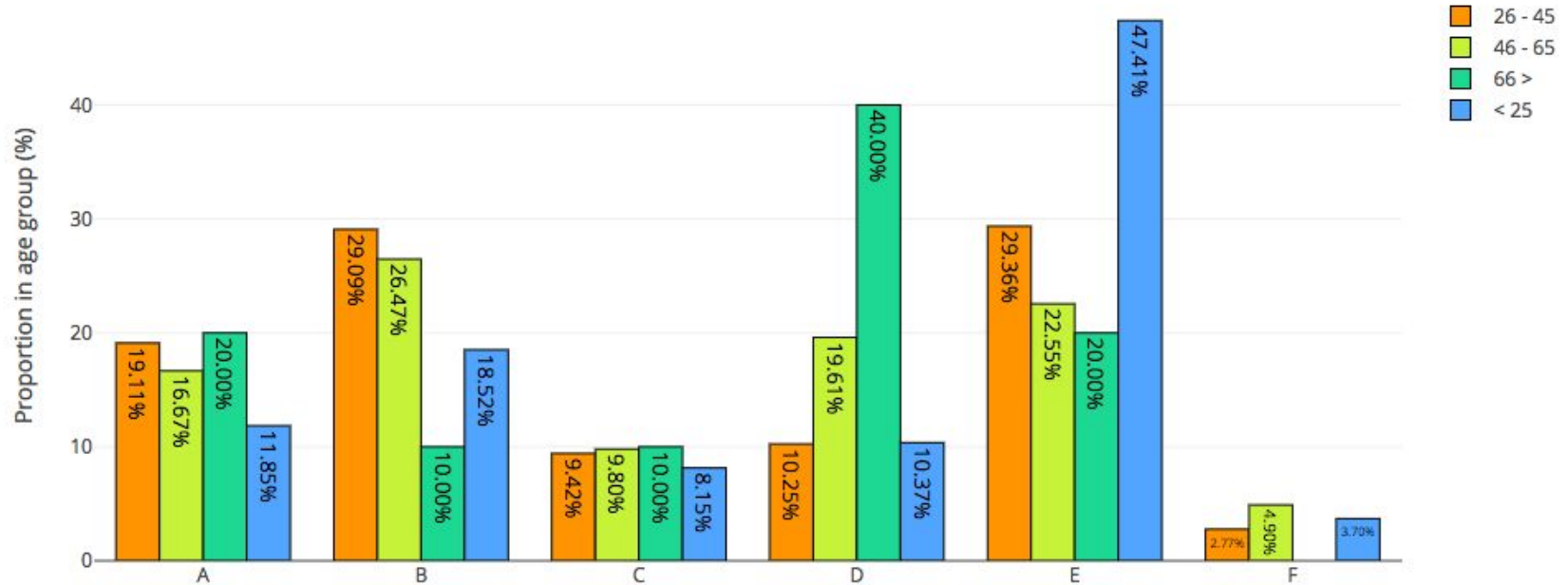

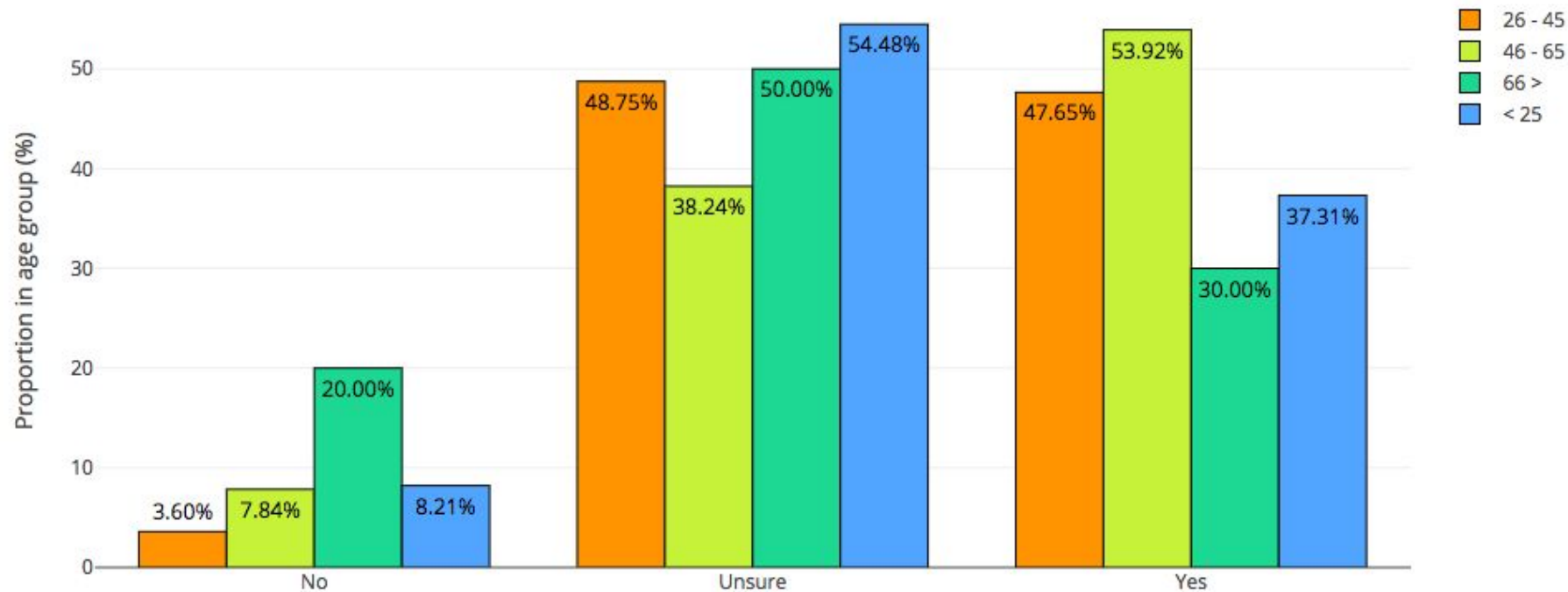

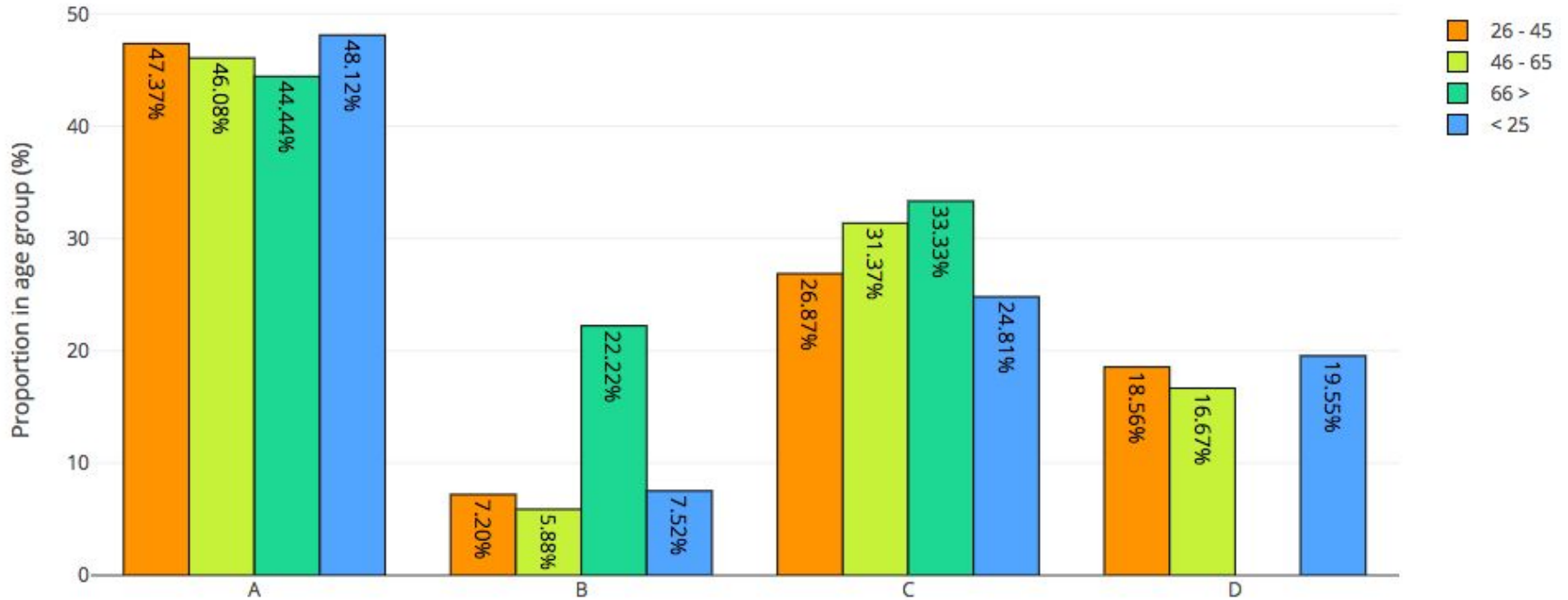

If you were to pay more for better environmental protection, which choice would you prioritise?



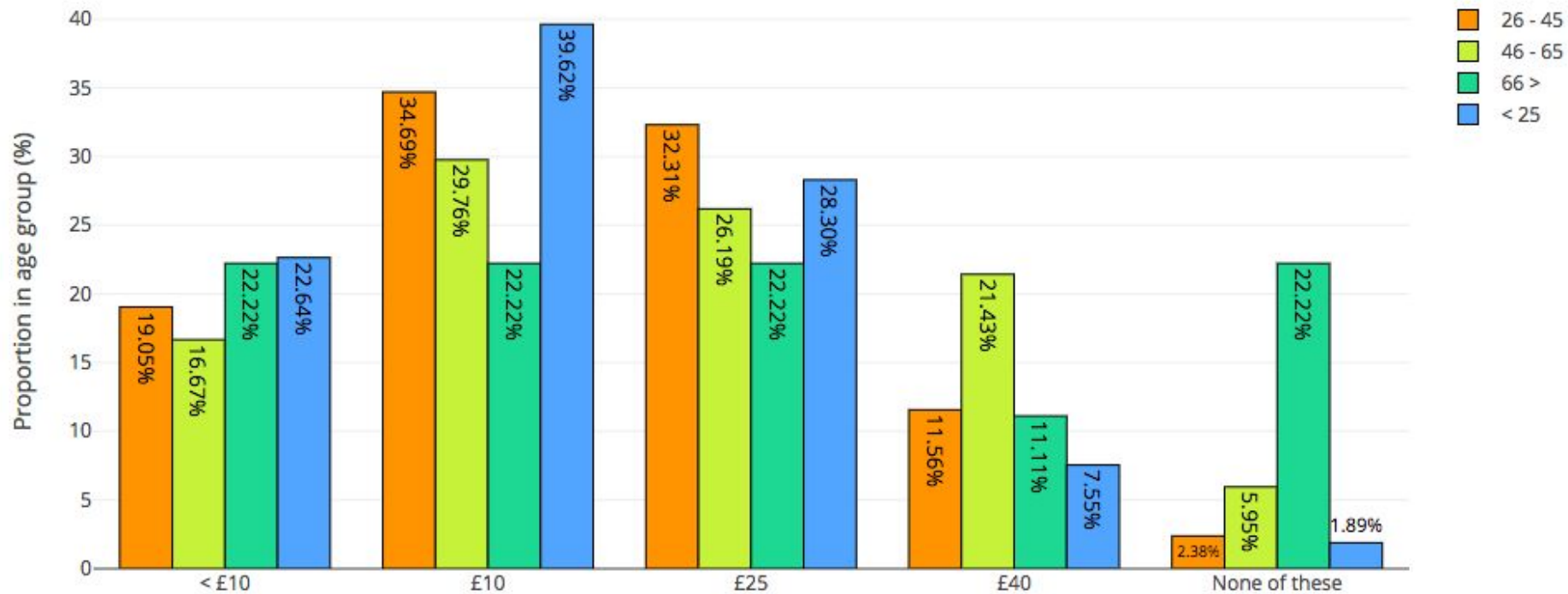

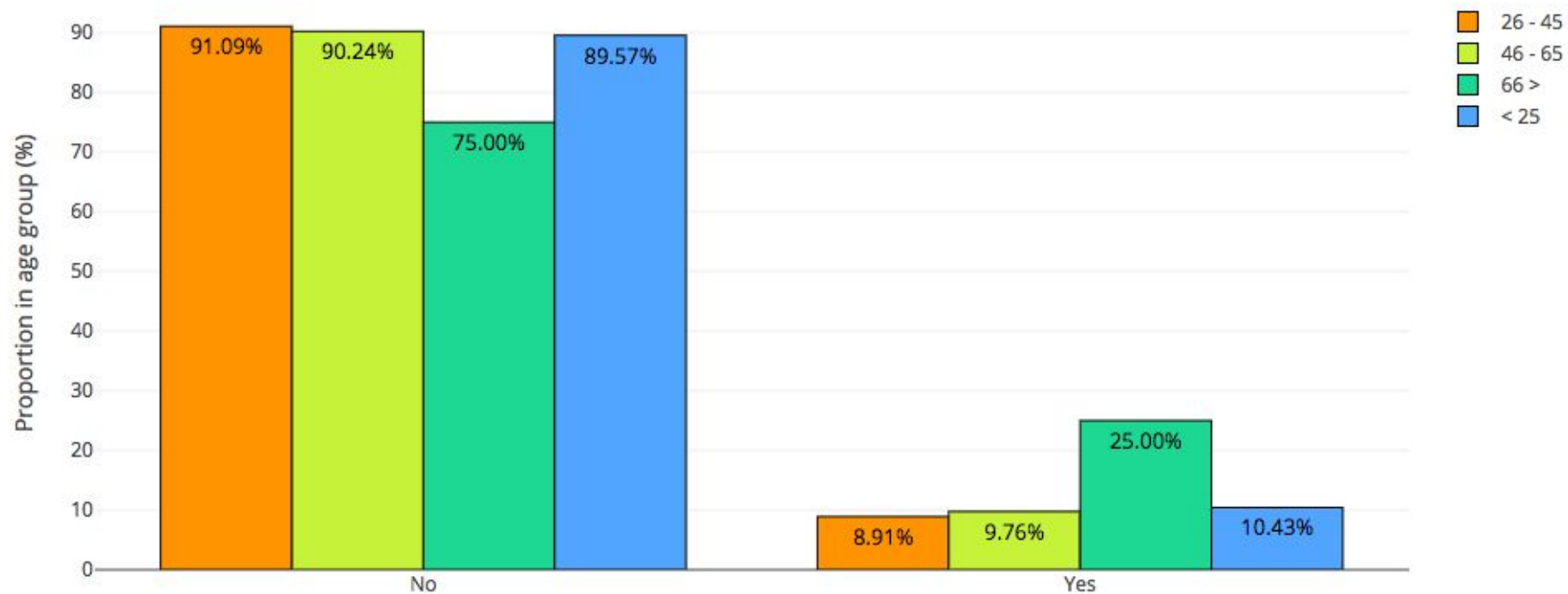
